As we enter into Holy Week this Palm Sunday let us endeavour to stay close to our Saviour in the coming days ahead by celebrating the important days of Easter Triduum. Due to COVID-19 some changes will take place as follows:

Maundy Thursday –

- The Washing of the Feet is omitted.
- No procession to the Altar of Repose.
- Watching in lieu of the Altar of Repose will not take place this year.

Good Friday –

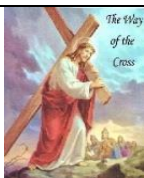
- Walk of Witness is not taking place.
- There will be **NO Veneration of the Cross**, instead the Celebrant will invite the people present to adore the Holy Cross whilst he holds the Cross higher for a brief time for the people to adore in silence.

Holy Saturday –

- This year we were unable to prepare those to be received into the church due to the Pandemic.

Easter Sunday –

- Masses as usual.

A call for meditations on THE WAY OF THE CROSS.

Due to the restrictions necessitated in places of worship by the COVID-19 pandemic, we wish to appeal that all who wish to join the parish in the

MEDITATIONS ON THE WAY OF THE CROSS this year, in addition to the already existing COVID-19 protocols, may do so provided people **MUST REMAIN**

STATIONARY AT THEIR SITTING POSITIONS, AND MUST NOT LEAVE THEIR SITTING POSITIONS UNTIL THE FINAL BLESSING as the priest leads the meditations from the Ambo without moving around too. This is the only condition under which we are permitted to have the stations of the Cross this year.

ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

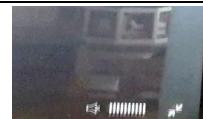
