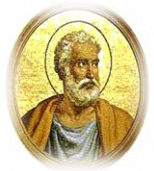

To mark this important day, Archbishop John Wilson will celebrate Mass at 10:00am in St George's Cathedral, in collaboration with the Southwark Commission for Promoting Racial and Cultural Inclusion. The theme of the Mass will 'One in Christ', offering an opportunity for all Christians to join together in reflecting on the importance of racial justice.

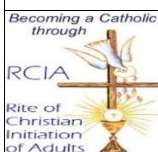

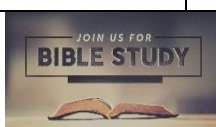
