Then the parish Synod team will be presented with the draft diocesan synthesis document on 17 March, and parishioners will then have until the 25 March to submit any further comments before it is finally submitted to the Bishops.

We are taking all suggestions on board and are currently working on initiatives which, with God's help, will make our parish grow better in Communion, Participation and Mission. Please let us remember that all of us are active participants in this call to journey together as a Christian family. May the Holy Spirit keep leading and inspiring us all in this supernatural adventure!
