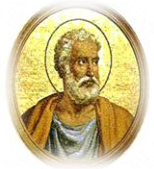

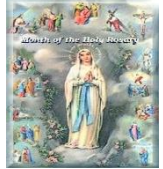

GREENWICH FOOD BANK

Greenwich food bank has been able to help feed many people, partly due to the support given by St. Peter's parishioners.

In 2021 Greenwich foodbank gave out 91,602 meals and so far in 2022 - 96,213 meals have been given out, so as you can see there is a greater need in our community and with the projected cost of living increased it will only get worse.

Items always needed are as follows:
Cereal, Milk UHT/powder (not fresh), Juice, Beans/spaghetti in sauce, Soup, Tin Tomatoes/Pasta sauce, meat, potatoes, mixed vegetables (peas, carrots etc.), pulses, tined fruit (peaches, pears oranges etc.) Rice pudding or custard, Fish, pasta/rice/noodles, tea/coffee/hot chocolate, bottles of squash, biscuits, condiments (salt, pepper, red/brown sauce, salad cream/mayonnaise.

It is important to note that the foodbank cannot give out fresh food, homemade items, or any item that the manufacturers seals have been broken for example large bags of rice opened and split into smaller bags, all items must be inside the best before date.

We are extremely grateful for any donations large or small, from individuals or communities within the church.

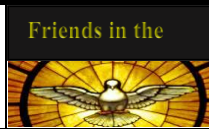
