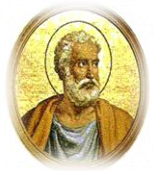

NOTE FROM ARCHBISHOP JOHN WILSON

This year marks the Golden Jubilee of Ordination to the Priesthood of Bishop Patrick Lynch. Bishop Pat has served the Archdiocese with distinction and generosity as a true shepherd to clergy, religious, and laity alike. His pastoral mission here for the past twenty-two years, the last fourteen of those as an Auxiliary Bishop, has been marked by passion for the Gospel, deep sensitivity, and a special care for migrants and ethnic chaplaincies and communities. 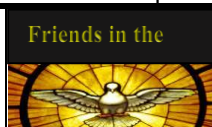
ANNUAL DIOCESAN DAY FOR CATECHISTS
