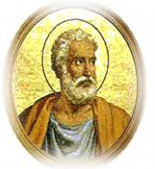

The gospels do not give us the names of the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. However ancient traditions give us their names as Joachim and Anne or Hannah. Joachim means, 'Yahweh prepares', and Anne means, 'Grace'.

Tradition has it that Joachim and Anne were childless for a long time, and that the blessed Virgin Mary their daughter was born to them in answer to their prayers.

Another tradition says that the parents of Mary were from Galilee. They later moved to Jerusalem where they died. As parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary and grandparents of Our Lord Jesus Christ, they are seen as models of parents and grandparents.
