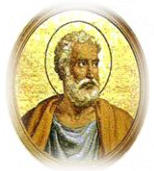

| <b>Saturday 18<sup>th</sup></b><br>6:00pm   | Holy Mass – Eileen, Michael, David and Mary RIP   | <p align="center"><b>Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary</b><br/> <b>21<sup>st</sup> November</b></p> <p>Mary's presentation was celebrated in Jerusalem in the sixth century. A church was built there in honour of this mystery. The Eastern Church was more interested in the feast, but it does appear in the West in the 11th century. Although the feast at times disappeared from the calendar, in the 16th century it became a feast of the universal Church. As with Mary's birth, we read of Mary's presentation in the temple only in apocryphal literature. In what is recognized as an unhistorical account, the Protoevangelium of James tells us that Anna and Joachim offered Mary to God in the Temple when she was three years old. This was to carry out a promise made to God when Anna was still childless.</p> |

**22<sup>nd</sup> November**

The power of music in Christian worship is obvious. Music can have many qualities - spiritual, emotional, theological, intellectual. We may respond in a variety of ways. Militant songs stir our spirits; quiet songs make us reflective; joyful songs cheer us up and so on. But most importantly our hymns are not intended as some kind of entertainment, but as an integral part of the liturgy. When churchgoers sit back and observe performances, then they are reduced to being consumers instead of participants. On this the feast of St Cecilia, patron saint of music, we are asked to emulate her example. Like any good Christian, Cecilia sang in her heart, and sometimes with her voice. She has become a symbol of the Church's conviction that good music is an integral part of the liturgy, of greater value to the Church than any other art.
