Saturday 25th 6:00pm 7:00pm – 8:30pm	Holy Mass – Souls in Purgatory Friends in the Holy Spirit – Christ the King Programme – Day 2	SOLEMNITY OF THE CHRIST THE KING OF THE UNIVERSE Today the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year, we celebrate the solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, the King of the universe. Jesus is the Lord. (1Cor 12: 3; Rom 10: 9). He is in all (Col 3: 11) He is the Alpha and Omega-the beginning and the end. (Rev 1: 8) And having made everything subject to him, he is 'all in all.' (1Cor 15: 28) It is only proper and fitting that we end the year with Jesus the Lord, by whom all things were made. (Jn 1: 3) Jesus is not only the creator of the whole universe, but he is also its ruler and judge. (Mt 25: 31ff); Lord over all creation. Jesus is King (Jn 18: 36-37; Rev 19: 13,16) but his kingdom is not of this world. It is a "kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love, and peace." While the kingship of the world is for ruling over people, that of Jesus is for service. He "did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mt 20: 28) He gave us the example of service by washing the feet of his disciples. "I your Lord and master have washed your feet...I have given you an example to follow..." (Jn 13: 14-17) This feast was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925. The monthly First Friday programme will take place this Friday 1ST December 2023. It will begin with Holy Mass at 9:30am followed by Adoration at 10:00am, Holy Mass at 12:30pm and conclude with Anointing of the Sick. This is a wonderful opportunity to spend time in prayer with Jesus. If you know anyone who is ill in your family or amongst your friends, please bring them with you.
