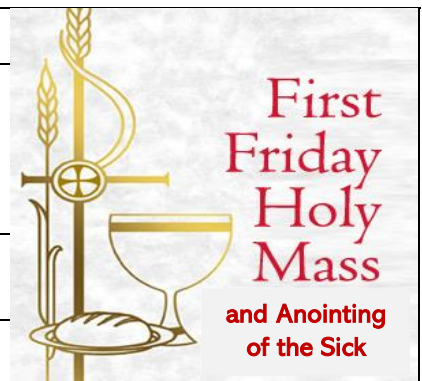

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**



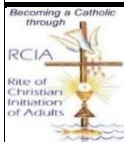
