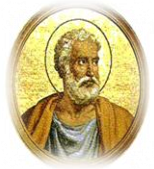

Please note: Parents should submit the Baptism Form and other relevant paperwork to the Parish Office before attending the programme.

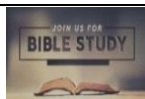
