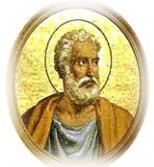

Coming at a time when civilization was torn asunder by war and violence, She promised that Heaven would grant peace to all the world if her requests for prayer, reparation and consecration were heard and obeyed.
