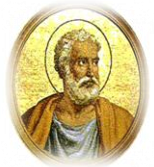

Last Sunday, we celebrated the sending of the Spirit, which sealed God's new covenant and made a new creation.

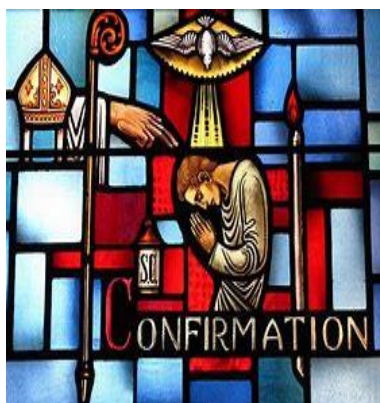
