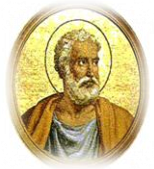

**Lev 6:12** *The fire on the altar is to be kept burning. It must never be allowed to go out...*

The church's tradition of lighting and burning candles, to symbolise our oblations and sacrifices in perpetual worship and adoration of God, comes with lots of spiritual obligations and blessings.

Religion without sacrifice is scandalous, and if our sacrifice must cost us something, as the scriptures declare through David in 2 Samuel 24:24, (*I will not sacrifice to the Lord my God offerings that cost me nothing*), then it is obligatory that each time we light a candle to burn, it must cost us something worth sacrificing: the cost of our candles is only 50p per candle.

May God bless and accept our sacrifices that cost us something small.
