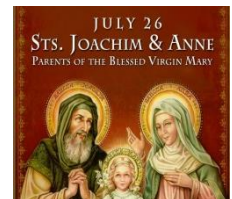

**MISSION APPEAL SPIRITANS (HOLY GHOST FATHERS)**  
We welcome Fr Michael Ezenwammadu who will be making an appeal on behalf of the Spiritans (Holy Ghost Fathers) at ALL masses this weekend.

The Spiritans are a Roman Catholic Religious Congregation founded in 1703. With a history spanning over 300 years, they currently have over 3000 professed and lay members drawn from all continents. These Spiritans carry out their mission of evangelization in more than 60 countries around the world. In UK they particularly serve in Parishes, Chaplains, Hospital chaplains and they have a Just youth project which help youths and the Revive Project which takes care of migrants



The gospels do not give us the names of the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. However ancient traditions give us their names as Joachim and Anne or Hannah. Joachim means, 'Yahweh prepares', and Anne means, 'Grace'. Tradition has it that Joachim and Anne were childless for a long time, and that the blessed Virgin Mary their daughter was born to them in answer to their prayers. Another tradition says that the parents of Mary were from Galilee. They later moved to Jerusalem where they died. As parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary and grandparents of Our Lord Jesus Christ, they are seen as models of parents and grandparents.
