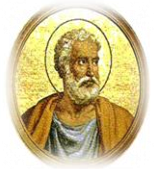

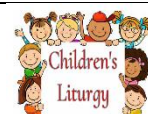
This Sunday there will be a 2nd Collection for Home Mission Sunday
