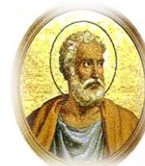

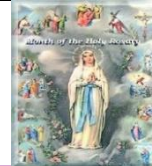
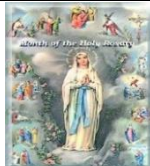

Sunday 10th November 2024 and Sunday 24th November 2024 after the 11:45am Mass.

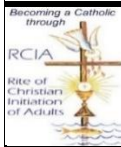
