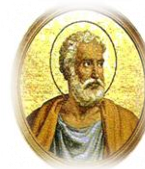

Given the presence of homeless individuals in our community and the use of St Peter's grounds, we are concerned about the security of the hall, especially as it is being hired out to another user during the week. We understand that our community hall is a valuable resource for many of us, and we want to ensure it remains safe and secure for everyone. To maintain this, we kindly request that ALL USERS adhere to the rules whereby it is left in good condition, including a clean kitchen and toilets, and all lights turned off and doors shut after each use. To ensure the safety and security of the hall for everyone, we must take these measures seriously. 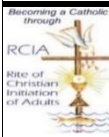
