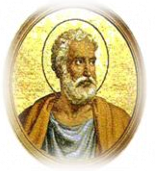

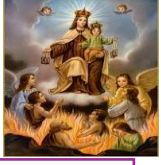

As followers of the Lord Jesus, he said: “we are called to care for those who are suffering, not to bring about their death”.</p> <p><i>A bill has been introduced to Parliament by Kim Leadbeater MP to legalise assisted suicide.</i></p> <p><i>This will be voted on by MPs on 29th November. We know that assisted suicide laws in other jurisdictions have had devastating consequences for the poor, disabled and marginalised. This is the biggest threat to the vulnerable in a decade, and we need a huge effort to lobby MPs to vote against the bill.</i></p> <p>Please urgently contact your MP and ask him/her to vote against the bill.
