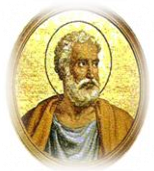

RACIAL JUSTICE – SUNDAY, 16TH FEBRUARY 2025

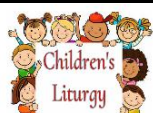
