#### St. Monica - 27<sup>th</sup> August Patron of Wives and Abuse Victims

t. Monica was married by arrangement to a agan official in North Africa, who was auch older than she, and although generous, as also violent tempered. His mother lived ith them and was equally difficult, which roved a constant challenge to St. Monica. he had three children; Augustine, Navigius, nd Perpetua. Through her patience and rayers, she was able to convert her husband nd his mother to Christianity in 370. He ied a year later. Perpetua and Navigius ntered the religious Life. St. Augustine was such more difficult, as she had to pray for im for 17 years, begging the prayers of riests who, for a while, tried to avoid her ecause of her persistence at this seemingly opeless endeavour. One priest did console er by saying, "it is not possible that the son f so many tears should perish." This lought, coupled with a vision that she had eceived strengthened her. St. Augustine was aptized by St. Ambrose in 387. St. Monica ied later that same year. On this feast day e pray for victims of domestic abuse verywhere, men women and children.

#### What is RCIA?

RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. It's a process in the Catholic Church that helps adults explore and deepen their faith, ultimately leading to full initiation into the Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

#### **RCIA Process\***

#### The RCIA process typically involves several stages:

- exploration of the Catholic faith. A period of formation and learning. \*Inquiry\*: Initial
- \*Catechumenate\*: 2.
- 3. \*Purification and Enlightenment\*: Preparation for the sacraments.
- 4. \*Initiation\*: Reception of the sacraments.

#### \*RCIA Purpose\*

#### The RCIA process aims to:

- 1. \*Introduce adults to the Catholic faith\*.
- \*Provide a deeper understanding of Catholic teachings\*.
- 3. \*Foster a sense of community\*.
- 4. \*Prepare individuals for full initiation\*.

#### \*RCIA Benefits\*

### The RCIA process can be a transformative experience, offering:

- 1. \*Spiritual growth\*.
- 2. \*Community support\*.
- 3. \*Deeper understanding of faith\*.
- 4. \*Full initiation into the Catholic Church\*.
