## Two Saints for Our Time: Carlo Acutis & Pier Giorgio Frassati

Today the Church will celebrate the canonisation of two extraordinary young men whose lives continue to inspire faith, service, and joy.



Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991-2006) was a teenager from Milan with a deep devotion to the Eucharist. Known as the "Cyber Apostle of the Eucharist," he used

his tech skills to create a website documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world.

We are honoured to host an inspiring exhibition dedicated to Blessed Carlo Acutis, a modern witness to faith, whose life touched many around the world. This exhibition offers a unique opportunity to reflect on Carlo's spiritual journey, his remarkable legacy, and the impact of his deep faith lived out in ordinary life. His story is especially powerful for young people seeking meaning and purpose in today's world. Carlo lived with simplicity, kindness, and a contagious love for God—reminding us that holiness is possible even in the digital age.

Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati: A Saint in Hiking **Boots** Born in Turin, Italy, in 1901, Pier Giorgio Frassati lived a life of vibrant faith. joyful friendship, and tireless service. Though raised in a

wealthy family, he chose a path of humility and compassion—dedicating himself to the poor, the sick, and the marginalized through Catholic Action and the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. A passionate mountaineer, Pier Giorgio often led friends on alpine adventures, combining physical challenge with spiritual reflection. He famously said, "Verso l'alto"-"To the heights"—a phrase that captured both his love of climbing and his pursuit of holiness. He died at just 24, yet his legacy endures as a model of youthful virtue, Eucharistic devotion, and social justice. Known as the "Man of the Beatitudes," Pier Giorgio reminds us that sainthood is not reserved for the cloistered-it can be lived in classrooms, city streets, and mountain trails.
