SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Today the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year, we celebrate the solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, the King of the universe. Jesus is the Lord. (1Cor 12: 3; Rom 10: 9). He is in all (Col 3: 11) He is the Alpha and Omega-the beginning and the end. (Rev 1: 8) And having made everything subject to him, he is 'all in all.' (1Cor 15: 28) It is only proper and fitting that we end the year with Jesus the Lord, by whom all things were made. (Jn 1: 3) Jesus is not only the creator of the whole universe, but he is also its ruler and judge. (Mt 25: 31ff); Lord over all creation.

Jesus is King (Jn 18: 36-37; Rev 19: 13,16) but his kingdom is not of this world. It is a "kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love, and peace." While the kingship of the world is for ruling over people, that of Jesus is for service. He "did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mt 20: 28) He gave us the example of service by washing the feet of his disciples. "I your Lord and master have washed your feet...I have given you an example to follow...

(Jn 13: 14-17) This feast was established by Pope Pius X1 in 1925.

Parents wishing to have their children baptised in DECEMBER 2025 should attend the Baptism Programme on TUESDAY 25th November 2025.


This programme will start at 7pm and end at 9pm and will be held in Pugin Place.
