



BAPTISM OF THE LORD



This weekend we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord Jesus, a moment that marks the beginning of His public ministry and reveals the depth of God's love for humanity. As Jesus steps into the waters of the Jordan, He chooses to stand with us—in our humanity, in our struggles, and in our longing for renewal. The heavens open, the Spirit descends like a dove, and the Father's voice proclaims: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." In this beautiful revelation of the Trinity, we are reminded of our own baptismal identity. Each of us, too, is called "beloved," invited to live as children of the light, and sent to bring Christ's compassion into the world.

PLEASE NOTE: PARENTS MUST FIRST SUBMIT ALL RELEVANT PAPERWORK TO THE PARISH OFFICE


