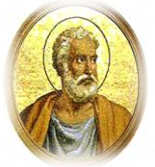

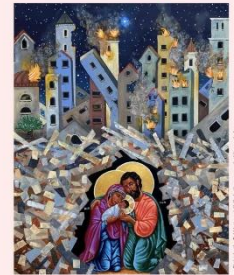
### AMBASSADORS FOR CHRIST:
