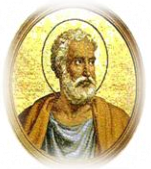

CHANGES AT OUR LADY OF GRACE - CHARLTON

Following discussions with the Archdiocese, the Spiritan Fathers will be relinquishing the pastoral care of Our Lady of Grace - Charlton with effect from 1 September but continuing to have care of St Joseph's - Shooter's Hill. The Archbishop and Canon Victor Darlington (Episcopal Vicar for the South East Area of the Archdiocese) have expressed deep gratitude to the Spiritans Fathers for the great pastoral care given to the community of Our Lady of Grace - Charlton.

The Archbishop has appointed Fr Sebastian Joseph as Parochial Administrator of Our Lady of Grace - Charlton with effect from 1 September 2026. Fr Sebastian is a priest of Quilon Diocese, Kerala, and he has been ordained 19 years. He has previously worked in the Archdiocese of Westminster for 8 years and he is currently Parochial Administrator of St Wilfrid's - Kennington Park. We know that a warm welcome awaits Fr Sebastian at Our Lady of Grace - please keep him in your prayers.
