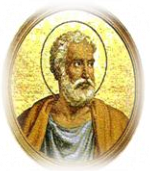

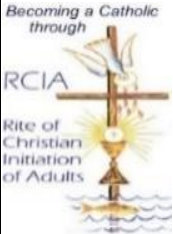
SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM
